

This set includes printed fabric for two Kitchen Tea Towels.



Printed - is the Right Side of Fabric



Solid - is the Wrong Side of Fabric

DIMENSIONS

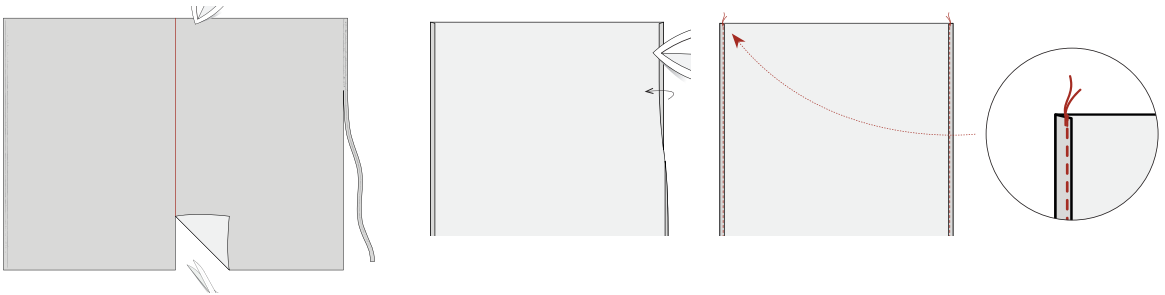
Dimensions (Size) of one panel with two towels is **44x32."**
The dimension (Size) of one finished kitchen tea towel is **20x30."**

Notions: Matching all-purpose thread.

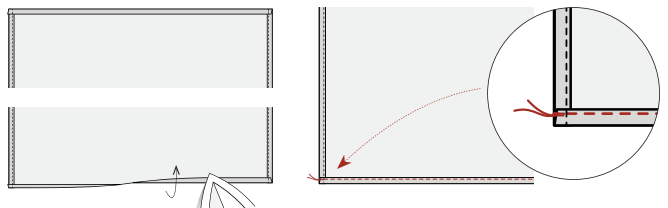
SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Iron your unwashed fabric so it is wrinkle-free. Cut along colored lines to separate into two towels and trim away any colored lines and the selvages.

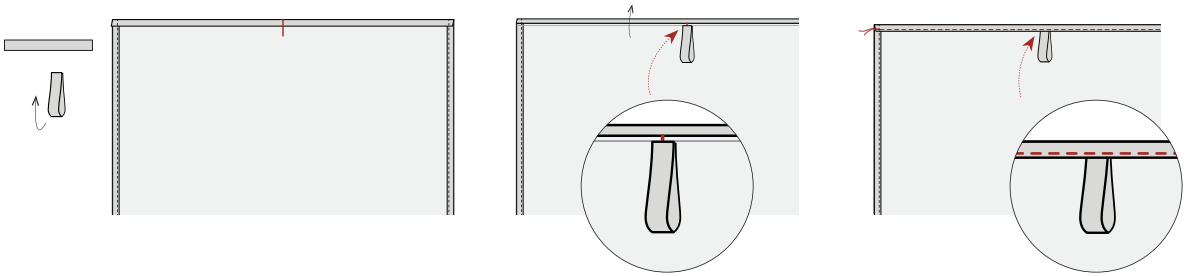
2. Starting with the long edges, fold $\frac{1}{4}$ " of the fabric to the wrong side (the unprinted side) and press. Fold the long edges another $\frac{5}{8}$ " in the same direction, enclosing the raw edge, and press. Sew the pressed edges close to the inner fold, making sure to backstitch at the start and finish of the hems.



3. Fold $\frac{1}{4}$ " on the shorter sides and press. Fold another $\frac{5}{8}$ ". On the bottom edge only, sew your hem as you did with the long edges.

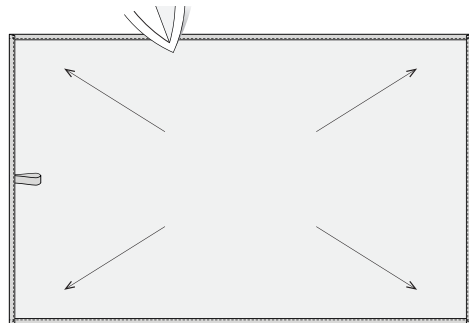


4. Cut 4" of twill tape per towel, and fold it in half for your hanging loop. On the side of the fabric with no print, mark the center point at the top edge of each towel with a pin, chalk, or disappearing-ink marker.
5. Open the $\frac{5}{8}$ " fold of your pressed hem and place the ends of one hanging loop at the center point. Then fold the hem back over again, enclosing the ends of the tape under the hem. Pin in place, iron, and sew the hem as you did before.



6. Trim away any loose threads. You can square out your fabric by gently tugging the corners of each towel in each opposite directions.

7. Give your hems a final press to set the stitches. Your towels are ready for a quick wash and dry, so they can join your kitchen in time for dinner!
